 (“The Spanish Navy” a.k.a. “The Spanish Armada”)

To Win the Game: You must create grammatically correct Spanish sentences to sink all your opponent’s navy.

Before you start: Write the correct form of the verb ser (“to be”) in each box.

How to Play:

1. Draw a ship in 10 spaces on your chart to represent your navy. (Fold this sheet so your opponent can’t see your grid.)
2. Try to hit and sink your opponent’s ships by saying a complete Spanish sentence by combining the subject pronouns with the verbs.
3. Your turn:
 - a. If you miss mark the space with una cara triste ☹
 - b. If you hit one of their ships, mark that space with una cara sonriente. ☺
4. Their turn:
 - a. If your opponent misses one of your ships say “falla”
 - b. If your opponent hits one of your ships say “acierto” AND put an X through the ship that was hit.
