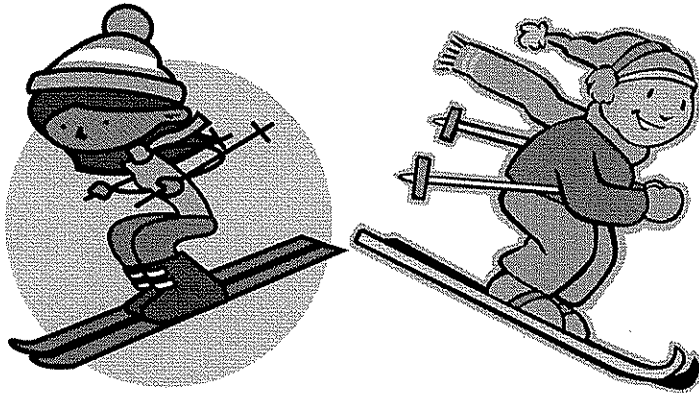


The After-School Activities Program Presents

- Cost: \$175
- Trip dates to NASHOBA VALLEY:
 - Wednesdays: Bus leaves from MS at 2:30 and returns at 9:00 p.m.
 - January 4, 11, 18 & 25
 - February 1 & 8
- Includes: 6 roundtrip bus rides, 6 lift tickets and chaperones. Ski/snow board rental **NOT INCLUDED**. You may bring your own equipment!
- Please make checks payable to DSMS. Checks are due Friday. **Please hand them to Mr. Dailey in room 124.** There must be at least 35 participants. Limited to 45.

Frequently asked questions:

1. Is the price for each trip? *NO! \$175 is for the bus ride and lift ticket for 6 trips! $175 \div 6 = \$29.17$. WHAT A DEAL!*
2. What time will the bus get back to school after each trip? *We will get back to the middle school at 9:00 p.m.*
3. Will there be lessons? *No. Lessons would cost extra and you would have to organize them through Nashoba Valley.*
4. If I can't go on all the trips, can I still sign up? *Yes, but the price is the same. \$175 gets you 6 bus rides and 6 lift tickets.*
5. If I already have a season pass to Nashoba Valley, can I still go on the bus with the ski club? *Yes. You would only have to pay \$65.*
6. Would I be able to eat supper? *Yes, in fact, I suggest you DO eat supper. You can buy food at in the chalet café or you could bring your own food.*
7. If I don't have my own equipment, can I still join ski club? *Yes. Nashoba Valley rents equipment. The normal price is \$25. Depending on how many people are in this situation, I may be able to negotiate a lower price.*
8. Do we have to stay as a group on the slopes or can we go where ever we want? *You're free to ski anywhere alone or with friends. If you prefer to ski with a chaperone, you can do that too. You must follow all of Nashoba Valley's rules AND all DSMS rules of conduct.*
9. If I miss a trip because I'm sick or absent, can I get refunded for that trip? *No.*
10. If the snow all melts before the last trip, will we be refunded? *No.*
11. If there's a snow-day and school is cancelled, will we still go skiing? *No, not as a ski club, but your lift-ticket will still be good so if you can get yourself to the slopes you can ski.*
